2024 RAISE – *East Deering: Pathways to Bridge the Gap Project*

\$25 million award **\$33 million project cost**

Partnership with MaineDOT, City of Portland, graduate school, and non-profit organization:

- Pedestrian bridge
- Coastal pathway
- Crosswalks
- City street rehabilitation
- Bike lanes
- Interstate off-ramp



2022–2023 CFI – *Recharge Maine Project*

\$15 million award **\$19 million project cost**

Partnership with MaineDOT and Efficiency Maine Trust:

- 520 Level 2 EV charging ports at workplaces, multi-unit dwellings, regional service centers
- 62 DC Fast Charger ports on interstate corridors and in communities
- Support EV adoption and use for residents and tourists
- Eliminate gaps in charging network; lessen range anxiety



2022 INFRA – *Presque Isle Freight and Mobility Priority Corridor Project*

\$44 million award **\$84 million project cost**

Partnership with MaineDOT and the City of Presque Isle:

- 6.3-mile U.S. Route 1 bypass
- Interchanges and overpasses
- Decrease freight traffic through town
- Reduce idling emissions
- Create safer and efficient mobility in population centers
- Allow city to transform downtown



2019 INFRA – *Madawaska International Bridge Replacement Project*

\$36 million award **\$74 million project cost**

Partnership with MaineDOT and the New Brunswick, Canada, Department of Transportation and Infrastructure:

- New bridge with expanded weight and traffic capacity
- Improve traffic flow at Land Port of Entry
- Facilitate cross-border mobility
- Restore international freight route closed in 2017 due to weight restrictions
